

Current HomeLink Classes Accepting New Students

Virtues Studies 2, Tuesdays, 1-2 pm, high school, cost: \$100/qt or \$40/mo (Feb-June)

Using Bill Bennett's *Book of Virtues* as the foundational text, students will focus on different virtues as presented in literature. Class time is spent discussing reading assignments and the virtues they present. This class earns an English credit. Taught by Laurel Smith

High School Literature, Tuesdays, noon-1pm, cost: \$100/qt or \$40/mo (Feb-June)

Students will read and study 6-8 of Shakespeare's plays, covering all the genre's of his work. Movie versions of some of the plays will be watched in order to understand the plays more fully. Taught by Ann Bowman.

Science Simulations, grades 2-5, Tuesdays,10-11am, cost: \$100 qt or \$40/mo Feb-June

Students will study space and volcanoes in this class where they pretend to be scientists. Taught by Diane Hanks

Math Tutoring, all ages, Tuesdays,10-11am, cost \$40/mo or \$10 per class (drop-ins welcome)
